

Council Study Committee
January 16, 2018
6:00 p.m.
Minutes

Members present: Council members Shirley Clark, Joe Gezel, Bob Kling, Greg Marchant, John Parker and Greta Southall. Absent: Mayor Kelly Shaw.

Also present were: Ryan Waller, Rick Graves, Diana Bowlin, Jason Etnyre, Chuck Burgin, Dave Button, Brian Sher, Greg Chia,

City Manager Ryan Waller discussed the Capital Crossroads Local Government Collaborative. Representatives from the City would meet with other representatives from the metro cities to discuss topics of interest.

Dave Moeller, Snyder and Associates, discussed the Jerry Kelley Trail Grant. This project was bid out in 2013 by the IDOT. The bids came in to high and the Council voted to not complete this project. Discussion included:

- Refunded the \$26,000 to STP
- Look at alternate projects – trail along Euclid to extend the on-street trail on Euclid and Kenwood
- Construct on Simpson as was first talked about
- Snyder and Associates would need to get approval from the IDOT for any change. If the route was change significantly then the process would need to start over. If the route was change slightly, IDOT may approve the change.
- An alternate change could cost approximately \$253,000 – if IDOT approves this change some of the grant money (which was \$290,000) would be returned. City could pay between \$86,000 to \$87,000.

It was the consensus of the committee to go with Option 3 with a fall construction. Snyder and Associates will talk with IDOT. If approved by IDOT, bids would be received by IDOT with a fall construction.

The committee also discuss the Warren County Jail meeting, most in attendance at this meeting was in favor of a north location for a new jail.
