

SPECIAL SESSION – JUNE 13, 2018

The City Council met in special session at 5:30 p.m. on June 13, 2018 in the City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Pro Tem Shirley Clark called the meeting to order and on roll call the following members were present: Shirley Clark, Joe Gezel, Bob Kling, Greg Marchant, John Parker and Greta Southall. Absent: Mayor Kelly B. Shaw.

Council member Kling moved and Parker seconded to adopt the following resolution entitled, “RESOLUTION APPROVING REVISED BOARDS AND COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP POLICY”. On roll call the vote was, AYES: Marchant, Southall, Parker and Kling. NAYS: Clark and Gezel. Whereupon the Mayor Pro Tem declared the motion carried and the following resolution duly adopted.

RESOLUTION APPROVING REVISED BOARDS AND COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP POLICY

Marchant moved and Kling seconded to amend the Board and Commissions policy to correct the scrivener’s error to state “The Mayor appoints a representative to the Greater Des Moines Convention and Visitors Bureau” and not the Greater Des Moines Convention Center. On roll call the vote was, AYES: Southall, Parker, Kling, Clark and Marchant. NAYS: Gezel. Whereupon the Mayor Pro Tem declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Southall and seconded by Kling to amend the Board and Commission policy to correct the error that the Mayor Pro Tem appointment requires approval from the City Council. It will be removed from the list of appointments that require approval from the City Council. On roll call the vote was, AYES: Parker, Kling, Clark, Marchant, Gezel and Southall. NAYS: None. Whereupon the Mayor Pro Tem declared the motion carried unanimously.

Council member Parker and Kling went on record stated the City Council is extremely transparent (they are not doing anything under cover), all action must be presented to the full council, they are working on what is best for the City and everyone needs to work together. Elected officials need to stop the negative remarks on social media.

Meeting adjourned at 5:50 p.m. on a motion by Marchant and second by Parker.
