

Council Study Committee
August 20, 2018

Minutes

Members present: Mayor Kelly B. Shaw, Council members Shirley Clark, Joe Gezel, Bob Kling, Greg Marchant and John Parker. Absent: Greta Southall.

Also present were: Ryan Waller, Doug Bylund, Diana Bowlin, Jason Etnyre, Andy Lent and Dave Moeller with Snyder.

Dave Moeller, Snyder and Associated, presented a concept plan for South “K” Street (the complete plan is on file in the City Clerk’s Office). Highlights of the plan included:

- Concept Study Results
 - Roadway type and typical cross-section
 - Cost Opinion
 - Implementation Plan
 - Phase 1 – Major culvert replacement - \$119,000.00
 - Phase 2 – K Street, West 14th Street – 2nd Avenue - \$3,194,000
 - Phase 3 – Relocation of “J” Street and signal - \$857,000
 - Phase 4 – K Street, W 17th Street – W 14th Street - \$1,150,000
 - Phase 5 – Underground electrical - \$2,409,000
 - Project funding and phasing
 - STP funds (\$600,000) FY 2019
 - CIP funds (\$119,000) for culvert replacement
 - Enhancement funds (trail and street trees)
 - Special assessments (local road portion only)
 - Voluntary assessments
 - Local capital improvement funds

Discussion included:

- Possibly looking at a slab on grade instead of curb and gutter
- Possibly a roundabout on “K” Street
- Additional development in this area would require a pump station
- Possibly abandoning the realignment of “J” and “K” Street – some committee members felt this should stay in the plan for future discussion – residents would like to see a traffic signal west of town

Consensus was to continue analysis on the above and funding for each.
