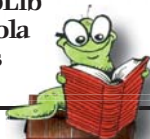

Spring Cleanup Programs

Annual Spring Curbside Program

The City's annual spring curbside pickup will run from:

Monday, April 16th to Friday, April 20th only

Items will be picked up the same day as your recyclables.

For a successful program, residents are asked to abide by the following program guidelines:

- Have items out on the curb by 7:00 a.m.
- Only large items not hauled through weekly service will be picked up.
 - No construction materials or railroad ties will be picked up.
- If you have items that are bulky and difficult to handle (such as swingsets) they must be cut up or dismantled into smaller pieces no longer than 4 feet.

FREE Appliance Drop-off at the Brush Facility

April 21st from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

One day only! Midwest Appliance Recovery will take appliances such as stoves, refrigerators, furnaces, dishwashers, dehumidifiers, etc.

Appliances Must Be Dropped Off at the Brush Facility

Appliances **ONLY** no scrap metal.

Spring Leaf/Grass & Garden Waste Disposal

The spring leaf and organic yard waste disposal program will be available **Free of Charge** from **April 19th to April 29th** at the Indianola Brush Facility during normal hours of operation.

The facility is located at the end of West Iowa and normal hours are:

Thursdays - Noon to 7:00 p.m.

Saturdays - 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Sundays - Noon to 4:00 p.m.

*Fees still apply for brush which is anything that is 1/2 inch or more in diameter
