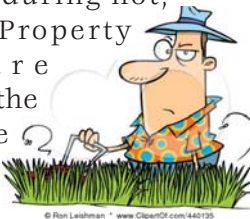


**Weeds & Tall Grass**

In addition to enhancing the beauty of the community, keeping grass mowed reduces the severity of some allergies, slows the growth of additional weeds, and significantly reduces the danger of fire during hot, dry periods. Property owners are responsible for the maintenance of their properties.

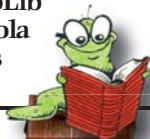
