

Utility Billing Alert

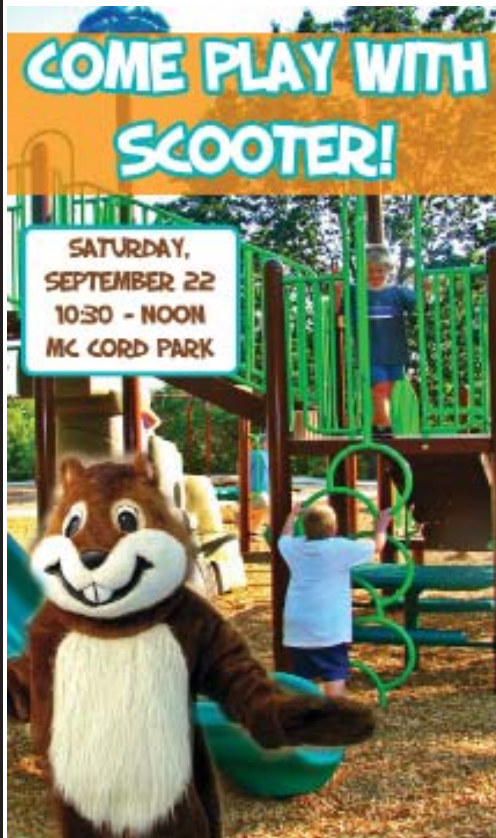
