PUBLIC NOTICE

City Ordinance 69.10 prohibits parking on any public street or alley during a snow emergency parking ban.

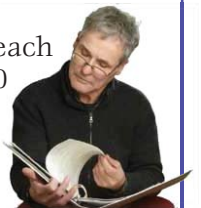
