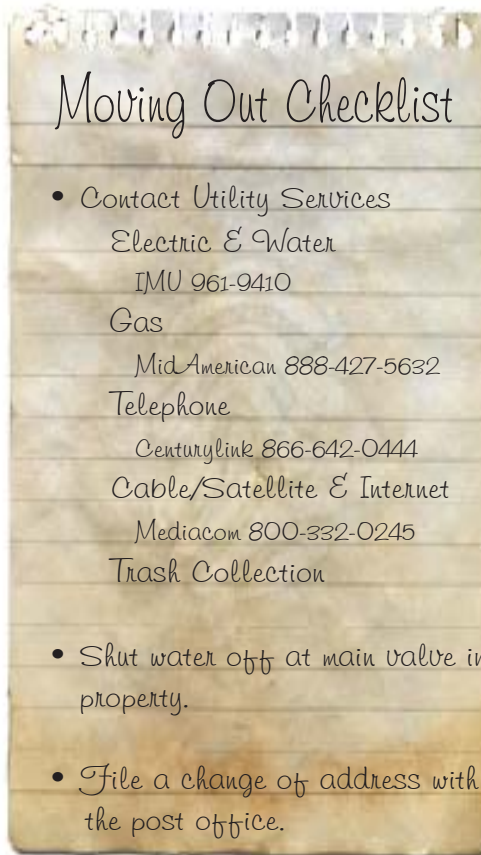
**Battery Recycling Drop-Off**
