## Basic Dog obedience

Sundays • Off-Leash Dog Park

This course is designed to help you train your dog, age 4 months or older, to become an enjoyable, well-mannered companion. Instruction will include walking on a loose leash, and commands like sit, down, stay, and come when called, as well as proper socialization with other dogs and people. Positive reinforcement methods will be used (such as food rewards). Classes will involve a high level of physical activity for both the dog and owner. Instructor LaDonna Hutchcroft has over 20 years of experience showing and training dogs. Note: Due to a class structure which involves a high level of socialization in a group setting, the instructor requests no pitbulls please.
