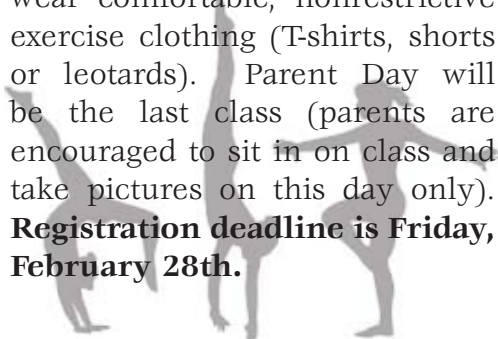
Once the items have been transformed into beautiful works of art they will be on display in city parks for your viewing pleasure.
