5k WALK OR RUN

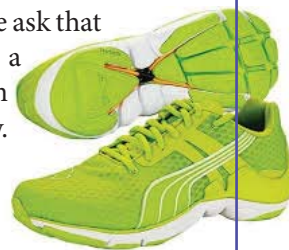
Saturday, October 25th
