About DeNelsky Park

Opened in 2008, DeNelsky Park includes trails, meadows, and a picnic area on 17 acres of land. A cell phone audio tour follows the mowed trail and brings to life the wonders of its natural plantings and wildlife. It remains a unique and wonderfully preserved Indianola park. The land was originally a farm, purchased by Minnie and Isadore DeNelsky around 1948. They raised cows, sheep, and chickens on the property. Minnie did most of the milking by hand, winning milking contests at the county fair. After Isadore died in 1950, Minnie returned to college while continuing to farm. After graduation from Simpson College in 1956, she taught Spanish and served as the librarian for Mount Ayr Community High School. Due to her other obligations, she gradually gave up farming. Minnie never lost her love for the land.

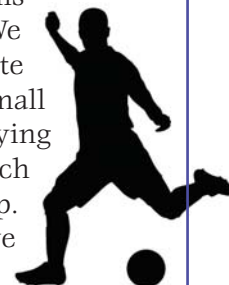

CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS

1. Call to order.
2. Roll call.
3. Approval of May 7, 2014 minutes.
4. Consider request from Al Thayer for construction of an accessory building on the property on real estate locally known as 3212 West 4th Avenue, Indianola, Warren County, Iowa, which is in an A-1 (Agriculture) zoning classification. The applicant requests an 858 square foot variance for a total building area of 1,908 square feet and a 3' mean height variance for a total mean height of 15'. Chapter 165 A-1 zoning allows for accessory buildings a maximum area of 1,050 square feet and a maximum mean height of 12 feet.
5. Consider request from Bryan Acuna for construction of a residential addition at the residence on real estate locally known as 610 North J Street, Indianola, Warren County, Iowa, which is in an R-1 (Single Family Residential) zoning classification. The applicant requests a 24' rear yard variance, leaving an 11' rear yard. Chapter 165 R-1 zoning classification requires rear yard setbacks of 35'.
6. Consider request from City of Indianola for construction of a one or two family dwelling at the lot on real estate locally known as 301 West Salem Avenue, Indianola, Warren County, Iowa, which is in an R-3 (Mixed Residential) zoning classification. The applicant requests a 15' variance of lot width, 150 square feet lot area, a 5' front yard setback, leaving a 20' front yard and a 3' side yard setback, leaving a 5' side yard. Chapter 165 R-3 zoning classification requires 60' lot width for a single family dwelling, a 70' lot width for a two family dwelling, 8,400 square foot area for two family dwellings, a 25' front yard and 8' side yard setbacks.
