Wood Mulch

Mulch is available at the Indianola Brush Facility during normal hours of operation free of charge. Individuals wanting mulch will need to provide their own containers and assistance is not normally provided except on the second Saturday of the month.

On the second Saturday of the month from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm assistance for loading pick-ups and/or trailers is provided for a fee of \$10.00 per load. The fee helps to off-set equipment and personnel expense.

Weeds & Tall Grass

The City of Indianola asks that all weeds and tall grass be kept mowed. In addition to enhancing the beauty of the community, keeping grass mowed reduces the severity of some allergies, slows the growth of additional weeds, and significantly reduces the danger of fire during hot, dry periods.
