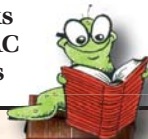

## Rivers, Roads, and Rails A Journey in Transportation

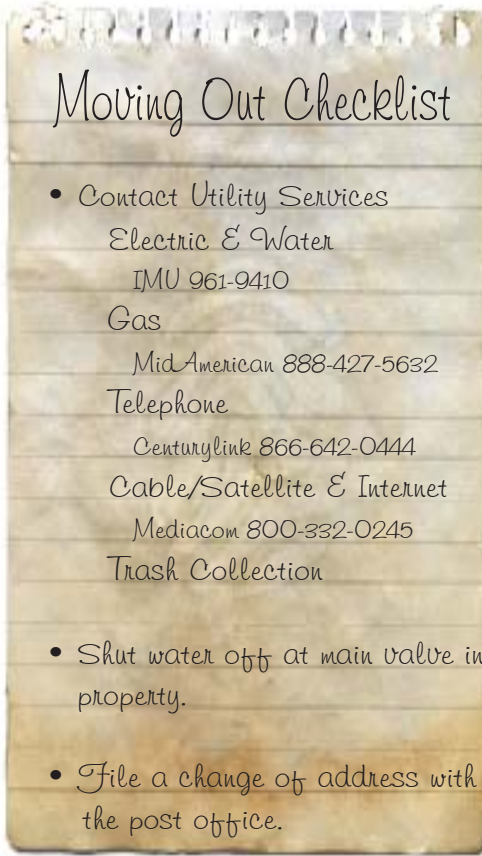
Monday, October 6th • 6:00 - 7:00 p.m.
