When voters last approved the local option sales tax, the ballot language stated that the moneys from the tax would be devoted "100% to costs related to the construction and/or rehabilitation of public safety facilities, public works, and street maintenance." The budget amendment diverts moneys from an account for construction of a wastewater treatment facility to pay for the project. The Streetscape Project is not a public safety facility, public works, or street maintenance and should not therefore receive local option sales tax funding.
