

## Indianola Public Arts Commission

### Meeting Minutes – April 22, 2021

Dan called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Tim motioned to approve the April 8, 2021 meeting minutes. Laurel seconded and the motion carried.

The group discussed that the by-laws need to reflect language indicating "the commission shall have 7 members". Grant will be apprised of needed change and the commission will table the vote to approve by-laws until May meeting date.

Mark True presented to the group again regarding the intent/mission of North River Arts Council. Mark indicated the need for a representative from the Indianola Public Arts Commission to sit on the council to further the work of the council and collaborate with other communities. Kim volunteered to be the representative from IPAC and confirmed with Mark that she needs to pay the \$25 membership fee.

The group discussed the pianos on the square project. Laurel suggested, and the group agreed, to start with one piano to test the complexity of the logistics. An informational letter will be drafted and sent to businesses on the square to gauge their level of interest/involvement in sponsoring and/or displaying the piano. Jim will bring examples of pianos/prices he has found to May's meeting to share with the group. Dan suggested having a budget up to \$100 for a piano to ensure getting a decent one.

The group discussed the IPAC logo drafts Grant submitted. Dan will send info to Grant to request revision of first logo with bolder font and tighter wording as indicated in second logo. The group will review revision at next meeting.

Jim motioned to hold future IPAC meetings monthly on the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of each month. Laurel seconded and the motioned passed. The next meeting will be Thursday, May 27, 2021.

Kim motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:06 p.m. Jim seconded the motion and the motion carried.
